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## At Home at Sacred Heart Model School

“Exemplary” is how **Mrs. Tricia Forde** is described by Dr. Mary Beth Bowling, principal of Sacred Heart Model School. Mrs. Forde has been teaching at SHMS for 19 years and is currently the chair of the Language Arts Department. In August, she was honored as the SHMS recipient of the **2011 Catholic Education Foundation Teacher Award**. The award recognizes a Catholic school teacher in the Archdiocese of Louisville who has a positive influence on the lives of students and utilizes innovative and creative teaching styles and best practices.

In this interview, Mrs. Forde talks about the joy of Catholic education and teaching at SHMS.

**What is special about teaching at SHMS?** SHMS is more

than a job. It is a family. The faculty has supported me as I raise my own family so that I could be able to be a good mom as well as a good teacher. I benefitted from this support when I battled breast cancer in 2003. I could not find this same support anywhere else. I am home at SHMS.

**What do you learn from your students?**

I learn from my students every day. They teach me the obvious – current fashions, current music and current sayings. But they also teach me that every child wants to learn and can learn. I am constantly surprised by what they can do if they are inspired.

**Why is Catholic education important?** I believe that all we are is a gift from God and I want to be able to spread this good news. I like being able to talk about literature in a Catholic context. For example, after my Holocaust unit, the religion teacher, the social studies teacher and I lead the students through an extension project where they strive to answer the question “Is war worth it?” They have to use the teaching of the church to analyze what they learned in their literature.

**What is your favorite memory or tradition at SHMS?**

I love the Level 8 graduation ceremony. When the students stand for the choral reading of Corinthians, God is definitely present in the Chapel.

Mrs. Forde earned a master’s degree in teaching from Bellarmine University and a bachelor’s degree in journalism from Northwestern University. She and her husband, Pat, have three children: Mitchell, a St. X student, Clayton, an 8th grader at Barrett Traditional, and Brooke, a 7th grader at Holy Spirit.
